- Importance of earliest possible attendance/interim advice
- We, the lawyers, may recommend immediate steps to obtain security from shipowners/the P&I Club to secure the claims



Establish Who is Who

- Owners
- **■** Charterers
- **Disponent Owners**
- **■** Managers/Operators







- Voyage History
- Date of Loss
- Date of Departure/Arrival at Discharge Port
- Article III Rule 6 of Hague/Hague-Visby Rules



Cover Causation not only Quantum

- **■** For example,
 - 7 Hatch covers



- → Contamination from other/previous cargoes



- Pre-loading and post discharge damage
- One bite of the cherry



Mitigation of Loss – Is it reasonable?

- Has the Shipowner taken reasonable steps?
- **■** Early segregation
- **■** Fair auction of distressed cargo



Obtain, if possible, Copies of Ships Documents/Evidence

- The eyes <u>& ears</u> for Insurers
