## THE RENDEZ-VOUS PARISMAT

## TO HIGHLIGHT THE KNOW-HOW OF THE FRENCH PLACE ACROSS THE WORLD AND ALLOW YOUNG TALENTS TO GROW.

Organized by the CESAM with the support of the Organizing Committee Members, the Rendez-vous ParisMAT is set up to showcase the know-how and knowledges of all actors in Marine and Aviation Insurance, actively acting on the French market. This also allows to strengthen contacts with foreign markets and to develop the assets of the French market place on the international scene.

Launched in 2009 in Cannes, the Rendez-vous ParisMAT has been organized since 2012 in Paris, a worldwide recognized financial center. Each year, more than 600 insurers, brokers, surveyors, average agents, shipowners, carriers, freight forwarders, logisticians, marine lawyers, risk managers, French Insurtechs or even teachers meet, discuss and debate about the evolutions the Marine and Aviation Insurance industry is facing.

Current topics impacting the sector are presented and commented on, whether they concern international trade, the shipping world,

regulatory changes and all aspects which can bring a relevant light on the profession.

In June 2021, these are 30 major players including in particular the Chief of Staff of the French Minister of the Sea, The French Secretary General of the Sea, The Chairman of the Air and Space Academy, The Commander of the MICA Center , The Managing Director of Corsica Linea, The Managing Director of the broker Verlingue, The Chairman of the AMRAE and Risk Manager of Veolia, The Chairman of the Union of the French Marine Agents, The Vice-Chair of the Marine Specialized brokers Union PLANETE CSCA-UCAMAT, The Chairman of CESAM , The Chairman of the COMAT, The Risk Manager of Louis Dreyfus Companies as well as the Chairman of SNSM.

It is also during the Rendez-vous ParisMAT that the Student Prize is awarded, rewarding, each year, the best thesis as part of a Master 2, in which the theme is a subject related to risks which falls under or is impacting the activity of Marineand Aviation Insurers.
