Organized by CESAM with the support of the Members of the Organizing Committee, the purpose of the Rendez-vous ParisMAT is to highlight the know-how and knowledges of all players of the Marine and Aviation insurance ecosystem operating on the French market. This also allows to strengthen contacts with foreign markets and to develop the attractiveness of France on the international scene.

Launched in 2009 in Cannes, the Rendez-vous ParisMAT has since 2012 been organized in Paris, a worldwide recognized financial center.

Each year, more than 600 participants from more than 40 different countries, insurers, brokers, surveyors, average agents, shipowners, carriers, freight forwarders, logisticians, maritime lawyers, risk managers, French Insurtechs or even University professors meet, exchange and debate about developments faced by the Marine, and Aviation insurance market.

Current topics impacting the sector are presented and commented on, whether they concern international trade, world of shipping, regulatory developments, evolution of the Marine and Aviation insurance market as well as, in general, risks covered by insurers; all aspects which could bring relevant information to the business.

- > Evolutions and challenges of tomorrow maritime world;
- Marine environment and maritime economy: insurers are looking for "sustainability";
- > Cyber risk: inventory and position of insurers;
- Risks and challenges presented by the complexity of the supply chain;
- > Consequences of the Ukrainian crisis for insurers;
- New standards for more effective fire-fighting systems on mega container ships;
- Challenges faced by the French Navy linked to the emergence of a new geopolitical cycle.

Round tables and presentations allow discussions and information to commonly approach the transport insurance market of tomorrow.

And because tomorrow also means future insurers, it is during the Rendez-vous ParisMAT that the Student Prize is awarded, rewarding each year the best Master 2 memory, written about a subject regarding risks relating to or impacting the activity of Marine and Aviation insurers. The 2022 Laureate was distinguished for his work about: "The freight forwarding put to the test by the coronavirus: prevention of litigation and evolution of contractual and commercial practices".
