Anomaly report Form

In an environment where combating fraud has been a major challenge for marine and transport insurers for several years, we are pleased to announce the creation of an “anomaly report” developed on the initiative of GENERALI and with the support of the members of the CESAM pleasure craft commettee.

Conclusions that were shared within the market have highlighted the need for greater awareness among those working in the field, such as pleasure craft surveyors. Indeed, you are among the first to identify signs of irregularities and play an essential role in detecting risky behavior.

To support and build this approach, a common “Anomaly Report” is now available.

The purpose of this document is to enable you to rely on objective indicators presented in the form with checkboxes and record, on an official and confidential document, any information that may arise some sort of suspicion of irregularities. Overall, the aim is to simplify and standardize the reporting of this kinf of information to your principals.

If needed, this form can be sent to your principals, on a confidential basis, along with the survey report.

We would like to thank GENERALI and all the members of the CESAM Pleasure Craft Commettee for their collaboration and remain at the disposal of surveyor for any further information.
