Indian Truckers Strike from 10th September 2025 at Kandla Port and Mundra Port (Gujarat region)

The Truck Owners & Operators in the Kutch Gujarat Region have advised that all transport segment associations operating in and around Kandla and Mundra Ports have collectively resolved to observe a transport strike from 10 September 2025.

This decision was taken due to prevailing poor road infrastructure / facilities, and repeated representations to the authorities which failed to find a solution.

Starting from midnight on 9 September and until further notice, movement of import and export cargo through Kandla Port, Mundra Port, CFS facilities, empty parks, and associated industrial units will remain suspended until further notice.

The above strike, even lasting for a few days, may result in significant cargo congestion at Kandla & Mundra Port, resulting in subsequent delays in cargo clearance and deliveries.

Kandla Port, also known as Deendayal Port, is one of India's busiest and most important ports, playing a critical role in the country's economy, accounting for nearly 10% of the total cargo volume handled in India. On the other hand, Mundra Port is India's largest container port, handling nearly 13% of total cargo volume of the country.

Due to the severe logistical impact which the above strike may cause, there is a possibility that the government authorities may respond and provide assurances to the truckers within a day or two, in order to avert this situation.
